

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Victim Services Let's Talk Victim



On March 12th, our team led post-academy officers through a 2.5-hour training called Let's Talk Victim. This training was created by our team of advocates and was recently improved to help provide law enforcement personnel mitigation techniques and best practices to engage with victims and survivors in a trauma-informed way. Each officer was also provided a handout to keep in their patrol cars with reminders of these tools, as well as helpful resources they can utilize to support their own self-care and mental well-being. We'd also like to give a huge shoutout to our incredible volunteer, Elvia, who accompanied our team to share her story. Thank you, Elvia, for your willingness to be vulnerable to allow participants insight into the lasting impact for victims and survivors.

Healing Journey

We are so excited to reintroduce Healing Journey with the first session that occurred on March 9th. Healing Journey is a group focused on prioritizing self-care during a traumatic event, while incorporating these practices into our everyday life. A new component to these sessions is "The Workbook" which will not only include every chapter of the topics discussed during the session, but also resources that are available throughout the nation and our state. Each chapter will be followed by an activity to put into action the topic of self-care that was discussed for that month.



Healing Journey will held virtually every second Saturday of the month in conjunction with Support Group at 11am (AZ Time).

Legislation

HALT Act

A heartfelt appreciation to all the dedicated individuals for uniting in support of the HALT Act, aimed at combating drunk driving across the nation. The Abbas Family Legacy to Terminate (HALT) Drunk Driving initiative stands as a beacon of hope, advocating for cutting-edge technology to enhance the safety features of new vehicles. The 60-day feedback period witnessed an overwhelming response, with over 2,000 voices rallying behind this noble cause.

Bentley's Law

Our team has been hard at work as we've been advocating for the passage of HRB2044. Designed similar to Bentley's Law, impaired drivers would be required to pay restitution in the form of child support to a surviving spouse or other relatives who are raising the children of victims until the children turn 18. In January, we spoke at a Judiciary committee and then in February, we had personal conversations with Arizona representatives on the importance of bringing this type of justice to families.



Unfortunately, after dedicated efforts by MADD and Representative Bliss, the sponsor of HB2O44, Bentley's Law has been opposed and will not be moving forward at this time in Arizona. While it hasn't worked out thus far, don't worry because your MADD Arizona team won't stop working towards a future of No More Victims.



Thank you so much to Jody Winters, Yarko Ruiz, and Beverly Mason-Biggers for their efforts in helping us move this bill forward and for their willingness to share their personal stories.




